Students in Grades K-8 wear uniforms during school hours; exceptions being made by the administration from time to time for special occasions.

Clothes must be kept clean and in good repair; replaced when they are outgrown or become faded. Families are expected to respect the Dress Code. It is considered the parents/guardian's responsibility to see that their children arrive at school properly attired.

There are two main suppliers for our jumpers and other uniform items, Educational Outfitters and Flynn O'Hara. Tops, pants and shirts can be bought from other retailers, using the guidelines below. Used uniforms, in good condition, are available from the PTO Uniform Closet.

## GIRLS' UNIFORMS

Tops

- Short or Long Sleeve, cannot be sleeveless
- White or light blue
- Knit shirt or blouse
- Pointed or round collar
- Solid white turtleneck
- Any garment, usually at t-shirt, that is worn under the uniform shirt may only be plain white
- All tops must be tucked in to waistbands at all times.

Pants/Shorts

- Navy blue (Grades K-8) or Khaki/Tan (Grades 6-8) uniform dress pants
- Navy blue (Grades K-8) or Khaki/Tan (Grades 6-8) walking shorts (no more than 1 inch above the knee) may be worn year round
- Appropriate shorts may be worn under skirts or jumpers but may not exceed the length of the skirt.
- Worn at the waistline, not below it
- Worn with a solid color belt
- No metal decorations such as exterior zippers, studs, or buttons are permitted.
- No knits, denims, or sweatpants type fabric
- No cargo pants

Jumper

- Grades K - 5 - uniform jumper, no more than 1" above the knee

Skirt

- Grades 6-8, uniform skirt, no more than 1" above the knee
- May not roll up skirts at the waistband

Sweaters/Jackets

- Dark navy blue sweaters, cardigan or pullover
- Uniform approved items can be bought at http://www.rokkitwear.com/dealhome/199/UNIFORM


## Socks/Leggings

- Navy blue, white or black crew, or mid-crew socks or knee socks
- Solid color; minimum of one inch above the top of the ankle bone
- May have a small logo on the side
- Navy blue, black or white leggings are also permitted in cold weather
- Navy blue or white tights may also be worn


## Shoes

- Dress shoes or gym shoes that fasten or tie at all times
- No slip-on shoes, slippers, sandals or boots

Jewelry

- Small earrings, one or two per ear, should not dangle more than $1 / 2$ "
- One ring per hand
- One necklace or chain with a religious medallion
- Watch
- Bracelet(s) if pre-approved by the school office


## Prohibited

- Cosmetics
- Nail Polish
- Distracting hairstyles or hair dyes
- Metal decorations on pants, tops or shoes
- Other items or styles that are deemed inappropriate


## BOYS' UNIFORMS

Tops

- Short or Long Sleeve

- Knit golf-type or oxford shirt
- Pointed collar
- Solid white turtleneck
- Any garment, usually at t-shirt, that is worn under the uniform shirt may only be plain white
- All tops must be tucked in to waistbands at all times.

Pants/Shorts

- Navy blue (Grades K-8) or Khaki/Tan (Grades 6-8) uniform dress pants
- Navy blue (Grades K-8) or Khaki/Tan (Grades 6-8) walking shorts (no more than 1 inch above the knee) may be worn year round
- Worn at the waistline, not below it
- Worn with a solid color belt
- No metal decorations such as exterior zippers, studs, or buttons are permitted.
- No knits, denims, or sweatpants type fabric
- No cargo pants

- Dark navy blue sweaters, cardigan or pullover

## Socks

- Navy blue, white or black crew, or mid-crew socks
- Solid color; minimum of one inch above the top of the ankle bone
- May have a small logo on the side


## Shoes

- Dress or gym shoes that fasten or tie at all times
- No slip-on shoes, slippers, sandals or boots


## Jewelry

- One ring per hand
- One necklace or chain with a religious medallion
- Watch
- Bracelet(s) if pre-approved by the school office


## Prohibited

- Distracting hairstyles or hair dyes
- Earrings
- Metal decorations on pants, tops or shoes
- Other items or styles that are deemed inappropriate


## GYM UNIFORM (Grades 1-8)

Students must wear the official black All Saints gym shorts that can be purchased through Educational Outfitters (see store information above). Shirts worn in gym must be an All Saints shirt from parish activities, sports team or spirit wear. Kindergarteners do NOT need a gym uniform. They stay in their school uniform for gym.

## SCOUT UNIFORM

Students involved in approved Scouting programs are permitted to wear their uniforms to school on their meeting days and for school pictures.

## STAYING WITHIN THE GUIDELINES OF THE DRESS CODE

If a student does not adhere to the code, or the spirit implied by the code though not specifically mentioned, the parent or guardian will be notified. The students are very aware of the dress code guidelines; parents have reviewed them and teachers frequently mention them in class. Stronger reminders may come in the form of points. This could lead to detention. Should this be ineffective, the child will be required to call his/her parent or guardian and ask that proper clothing/items be brought to the school. It is important that students accept responsibility for their actions and that parents support the guidelines.

For special occasions, such as a school program, students may need specific attire. The principal will make the final judgment as to whether or not clothing meets dress code standards. If there are any questions about specific items, parents/guardians are invited to bring the item(s) to the school office before the tags are removed to have them approved.
